



Faenza depurazioni

Established in 1987, Faenza Depurazioni (Water Treatment) treats industrial wastewater. All the water used in industrial processes must be carefully treated until it falls within the limits prescribed by the legislation in force.

Faenza Depurazioni plant serves mainly the activities of the Tampieri Group, that is, the oil mill and the power plant. Yet, shrewd business acumen and facility capacity have made it possible to extend the service also to wastewater from third parties, thus providing the necessary support to many local companies.

Once treated to remove any toxic substance, water is partly returned to the surface water network and partly discharged back into the Group's industrial site, where it is used for such ancillary purposes as fire-fighting, washing and cooling.

Faenza Depurazioni's modern technologies allow for physico-chemical and biological treatment that can reduce high levels of organic and chemical pollution. Two test laboratories, one inside and the other outside the company, monitor all the stages of the treatment.

Every year Faenza Depurazioni can treat and return to the surface water network over 700,000 m³ of wastewater, thus bringing about sustainable development in the region.

Sustainability and respect for the environment are, and have always been, the mission of Faenza Depurazioni.
